It is our intent to do all we can to keep as many healthy students in the classroom as possible. It is our sincere hope and fervent prayer that we reach a mask-optional policy in mid-January. Our Covid Taskforce and Leadership Team believe that after holiday travel, we will be in a position to re-evaluate our policy should returning students demonstrate a preponderance of good health. Students will return to school, after the break, continuing to wear masks while inside our buildings. We will evaluate any Covid-19 cases at that time and hopefully discern a mask-optional policy start-date in the near future.
